

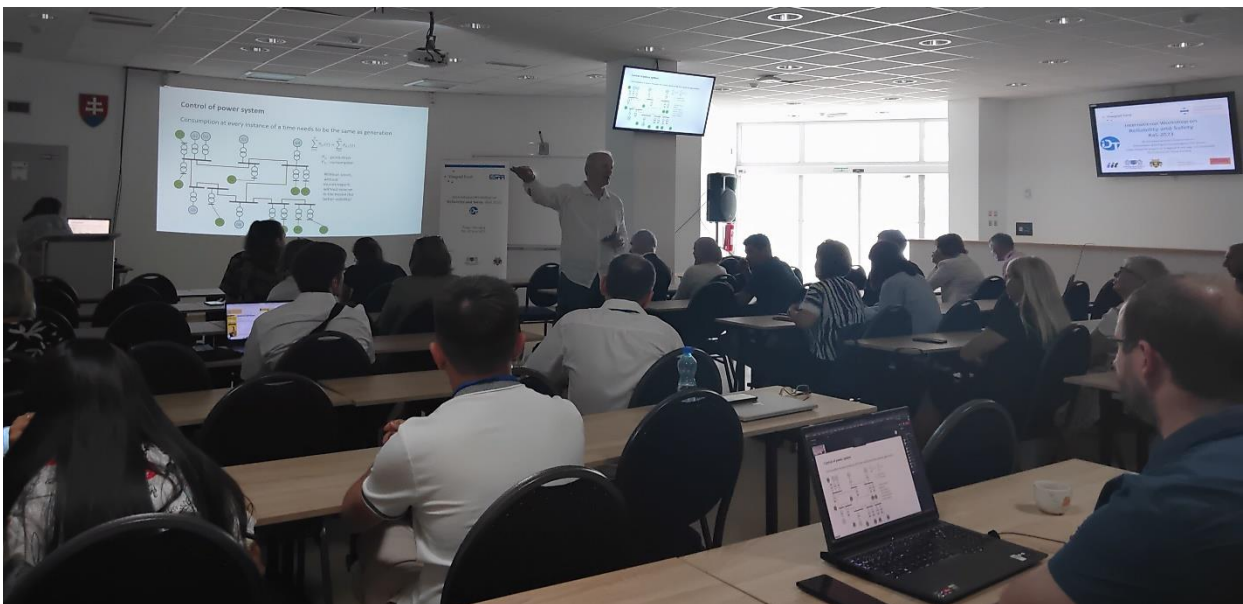

ERaSEV4 Project Participants Took Part in the Workshop on RaS 2023

More than 60 representatives of West and East European universities participated in the International Workshop on Reliability and Safety (RaS) held on June 20-22, 2023 in Žilina, Slovakia. The main workshop's objectives were (a) the establishment of collaboration between the target groups: young researchers, academic teachers, and representatives of enterprises in the Reliability and Safety area; (b) the discussion of the modern trends and teaching aspects in Reliability and Safety.

University teachers, scientists, and young researchers met for the three-day workshop held at the University of Žilina to discuss the current state and progress in Reliability and Safety. ERaSEV4 aims to provide a new platform for young researchers and teachers in order to assist and train them. "Improvement of support of teachers and researchers provides an environment for the development of science", said dr. Peter Kohani, vice-rector of the University of Žilina. "ERaSEV4 is an integrating product per universities of the V4 region," said prof. Vitaly Levashenko, the head of the ERaSEV4 project.

Prof. Vitaly Levashenko from the Institute of Information Technologies (Slovakia) leads the project consortium consisting of five universities and organizations from the Visegrad region: Gdansk University of Technology, VSB - Technical University of Ostrava, University of Debrecen, University of Žilina, and Institute of Information Technologies. Participants from these organizations joined forces to draw the first lines of the future platform of ERaSEV4. Improving conditions of teachers and researchers in Reliability and Safety and involving young researchers in real research projects of new participants are expected to raise the quality level of higher education in all areas of Reliability and Safety.
